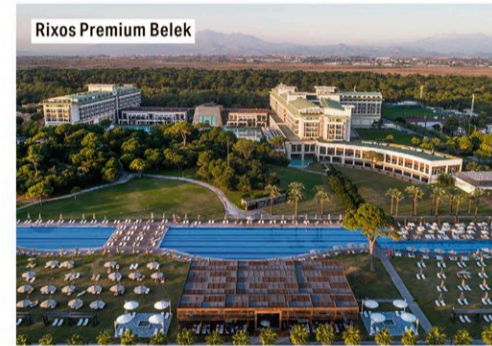

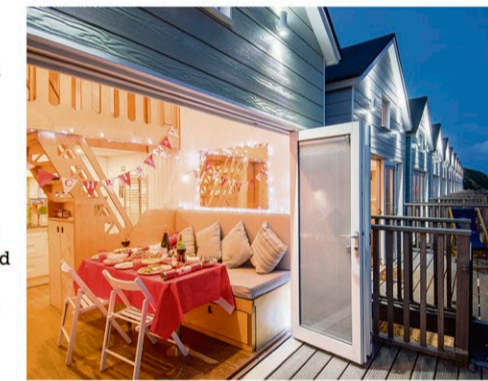


Winter and festive joy by the seaside

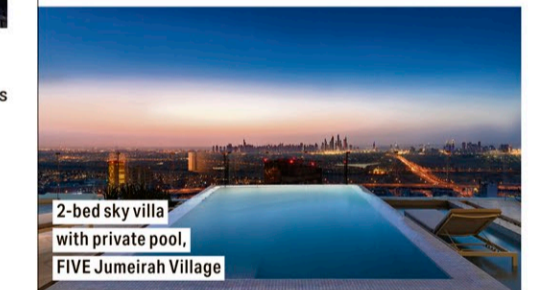
